

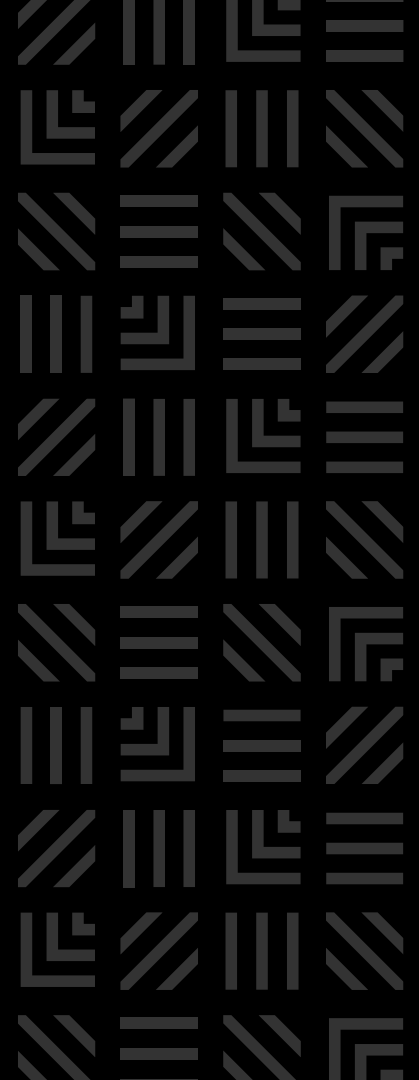

Our Mission

Create and support one-to-one mentoring relationships that ignite the power and promise of youth.

Mentoring Is

A cost-effective, data proven intervention to empower, inspire, and lead youth to their optimal physical and emotional health.



Youth with a Mentor

- **52%** more likely to stay in school
- **46%** more likely to avoid drugs
- **27%** more likely to avoid alcohol

About Our Littles

- Enroll ages 6 - 14 years
- All Littles and their guardians agree to participate
- Single parent homes/relatives
- Low socioeconomical status
- Struggling in school, low self esteem
- History of trauma



The Need

- **1 in 3** kids growing up without a mentor
- Boys wait **2 ½** times longer for a mentor
- Our goal is every youth will be matched within **6** months

What Makes BBBS Unique

- One-to-one
- 1-year commitment (minimum)
- On-going case management & match support

Our Programs

Community Based:

- Outings and activities are year-round

School Based:

- Weekly at school during academic year



Our Programs

Bigs with Badges: Connecting law enforcement and public safety officials with youth

Trauma-Informed Care: Training for mentors and parents

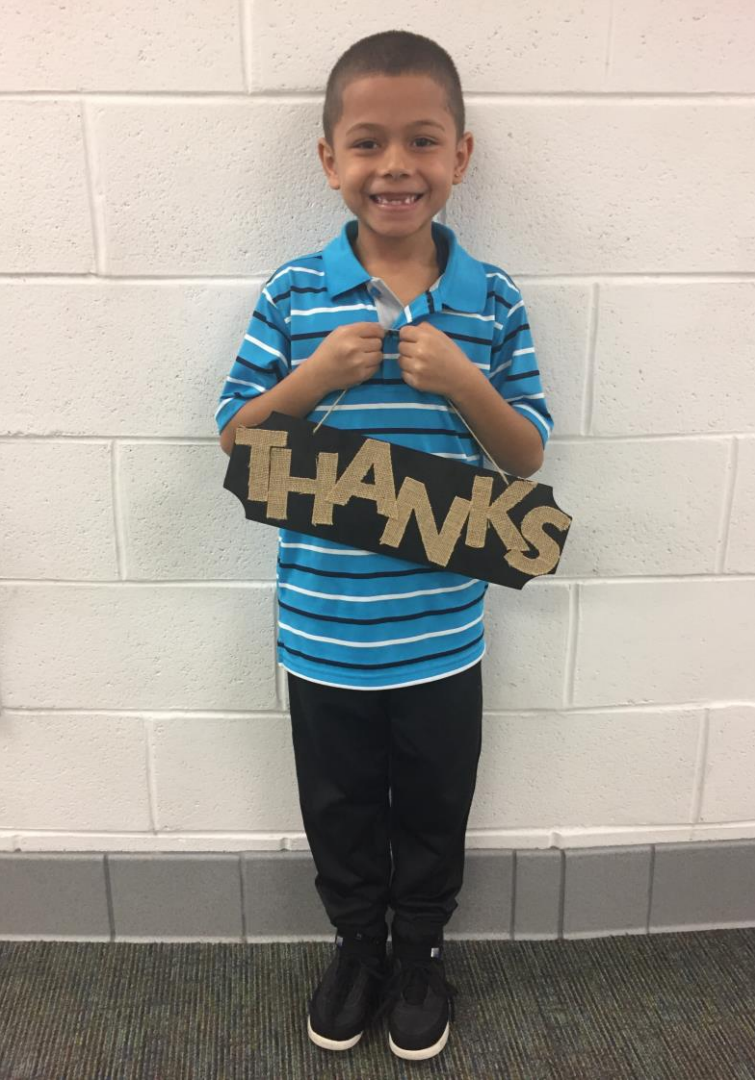
