### Player Eligibility and Age Verification

To be eligible, golfers may not have already attended college. Golfers who qualify **will be required** to submit a copy of their birth certificate, drivers license, baptismal record or passport.

### How to Qualify

In order to play in the Optimist International Junior Golf Championship, golfers must meet one of the following qualifying methods:

- *District Qualifying Tournaments: Optimist Districts conduct official qualifying tournaments. These events are organized by Optimist volunteers and are overseen by a District Chairperson. A limited number of golfers in each division qualify for the Championship. To view a list of qualifying tournaments and more details, go to [www.optimist.org/golf](http://www.optimist.org/golf). - *Exemptions: Optimist International offers a limited number of exemptions into the Optimist International Junior Golf Championship.*

### Tournament Format

### Rules and Regulations

The championship will be played in accordance with all USGA and local course rules. Local rules will be covered at player orientation (**which is mandatory**). All participants are responsible for following the Optimist Golf Code of Conduct, which is available at [www.optimist.org/golf](http://www.optimist.org/golf) and will be sent to all accepted golfers. A spectator code of conduct will also be in effect for all non-participants.

### Rankings

The Optimist International Junior Golf Championship is included in the *Junior Golf Scoreboard*, *Golfweek* and *World Amateur* junior rankings (16-18 divisions only for *Golfweek* and *World Amateur* rankings).

The OPTIMIST is also included in the AJGA's "Performance Based Entry system". Top finishers in certain age divisions are eligible for AJGA exemptions or earn Junior All-Star exempt status. For more information, go to [www.ajga.org](http://www.ajga.org).

## Courses and Yardages

Golfers will play on the courses at Trump National Doral Resort and Spa as follows. Yardages are posted on website. Course assignments are **subject to change**.

Boys 10-11.....Gold Palm course

Boys 12-13.....Blue Monster course

Girls 10-12.....Red Tiger course

Boys 14-15.....Blue Monster and Gold Palm courses

Girls 13-14.....Red Tiger Course

Boys 16-18.....Blue Monster, Gold Palm

Clash of the Challengers — Red Tiger course

Girls 15-18.....Red Tiger and Gold Palm course

Clash of the challengers—Gold Palm course

## Carts, Pull Carts and Caddies

Electric/battery operated pull carts and caddies are prohibited in all divisions.

**Handicapped carts** — the only spectator carts allowed on the courses during tournament days are for spectators with documented medical condition, handicap or disability. Spectators must send a letter from their physicians to obtain a golf cart. This letter must be received by email to (golf@optimist.org) no later than Wednesday, July 10. (There is limited availability of these carts per course—which are first come first served). Guests must follow the guidelines as noted on website.

## Distance Measuring Devices

Distance measuring devices are permitted. You may use these devices to measure distance only.

## Financial Assistance

Each participating District may sponsor the first place winner in the Boys 16-18 and Girls 15-18 divisions from their own District to the championship. Sponsorship includes the all-inclusive registration fee. If funds allow, Districts may pay winners of other divisions. If a junior golfer qualifies outside of his/her home District, we cannot guarantee the golfer's registration fees will be paid should they win the event. Restrictions apply. Check with your District Chairperson for details. Optimist Junior Golf Tour Events and Tournament of Champions do not qualify for financial assistance.

## Championship Awards

For the international championship, trophies will be awarded for 1st, 2nd and 3rd place in each division. In case of ties, there will be a sudden-death playoff for 1st place only. 2nd and 3rd place ties will be determined by a scorecard playoff.

## Optimist Parent-Child Classic

Parent-Child Tournaments will be offered on July 21 and 26. It's open to two-player teams consisting of a junior golfer playing in the Championship. Competition is an 18-hole stroke play event played on the Blue Monster (no handicaps). The entry fee is \$240 US per team includes round (green/cart), Optimist gift package. Awards immediately following play. **Space is limited.**

## Accommodations and Registration

Trump National Doral Resort and Spa Miami, FL, USA is the location of the championship. All hotel registrations are handled through Optimist International. **DO NOT call Doral Resort and Spa directly to book reservations.**

### **REGISTRATION FEES NOTED BELOW INCLUDE**

- Golf for the golfer (includes tournament rounds only)
- practice rounds must be booked and paid for by the individual player
- five (5) nights lodging for the golfer and all guests (see applicable prices),
- Five (5) breakfasts and four (4) dinners for the golfer and guests, (lunch on your own)
- access to all Optimist functions and special events for the golfer and guests.

Due to the exclusive nature of the event, **golfers are required to stay at Trump National Doral Resort and Spa Miami and pay the inclusive registration fee.** Guests are not required to stay at Trump National Doral Resort, but are encouraged to do so. A parent or guardian must stay with golfers ages 13 and under. No golfer age 13 and under will be permitted to stay in a room by themselves.

## Additional Room Nights

## Meals

**All registered golfers and guests** will receive a meal badge valid for 5 breakfasts and 4 dinners. These meals will be served daily, buffet-style, at Trump National Doral. **Lunch is NOT included in the registration package.** Participants and guests are on their own for lunch.

## Commuters

Optimist Junior Golf offers commuter status only to players who **reside and attend school in the Florida counties of Broward and Miami-Dade.** The registration fee is \$425. The 1st place District Winner discount does not apply to Commuters. The commuter fee includes tournament rounds and access to all Optimist functions and special events.
