Whitey – Uhhh - February 30????

Karl – comment, ask Fraser

Fraser – Friday November 29

Karl – comment 9:00, with teams 1 and 2 arriving earlier to set up trees, anyone can help

For Fraser

NAME the location of the tree lot

Fraser – Needles, Arizona

Karl – comment, ask Whitey

Whitey – behind the Centerville License Bureau on John Kalaman Way

Karl – comment, guests of license bureau. Park behind city building or in lot in front of Famous

For Whitey

NAME the most likely number of trees that are expected to be sold this year

Whitey – oh ahh, 13???

Karl – comment, ask Fraser

Fraser – how about around 900

Karl – comment – allocation same as last year

For Fraser

NAME the most popular tree we sell

Fraser – of course it's ME – THE Fraser Fir

Whitey – you're an arrogant sap (pause) ling

Everyone knows it's ME, the White Pine, because I'm very pleasing to the touch for everyone, especially any cats in the house

Karl – Comment on the 5 different types of trees we offer – Fraser, Balsam, Douglas, White (did not have last year), Scotch. Renowned Concolor are still in penalty box

Have over 500 Frasers between 6 and 8 feet

For Whitey

NAME the tallest member of the Conifer families

Whitey – it's my cousin, the Debe Dockins Scotch Pine, who can stretch to almost 5 feet tall

Karl – comment, ask Fraser

Fraser – it's someone whom we have spoken about for quite a while – you will look up to my grandfather, the Mark Twain Fraser Fir

Karl – comment

We used to get Twain size firs, but we have now cut back on size

Explain a Twain

sizes 3' scotch to 10' Frasers, most 6-8'

For Fraser

NAME the fee that Conifers charge for brightening up a home

Fraser – I bill at \$250 per hour, a lot less than most lawyers

Karl – comment, ask Whitey

Karl comment – ask Fraser

Karl comment – review other items, stands, wreath, door sprays, roping, boughs, and yes, the always popular Prolong

NAME the patriarch of the Conifer family

Fraser – why it's famous General Douglas MacArthFIR

Karl comment – ask Whitey

Whitey – We all know its Sergeant Pepper Door Spray

Karl comment – Whitey you are the closest. It's your tree lot Captain. Explain teams / captain will contact

For Whitey

NAME the one of the most valuable members of your family

Whitey – my Grandfather, Douglas Fairbanks, who lives in Alaska

Karl comment, ask Fraser

Fraser - Johnny Cashier Pine

Karl comment – talk about cashier responsibilities

For Fraser

NAME the time that customers are welcome to come look at your beauty

Fraser – Like JaMarr Chase and 7/11 – I'm open 24/7

Karl comment

Whitey – Like Dolly ParDON Me, 9-5

Karl comment – Tree lot open times – M-F 1-8, Sa Su and Opening day 9-8

For Whitey

NAME the way that CNO members are appreciated for their work at the tree lot

Whitey – they all get a free candy cane and stale coffee

Karl comment

Fraser – I'd rather not O PINE on that one

Karl comment – CNO members who work at least 3 times at lot (including set-up and delivery day) can receive a 50% discount up to a maximum discount of \$75 on any one item purchased

For Fraser

NAME the most appropriate attire that you will see at the tree lot

Fraser – what my squirrely, hang-around friends, CHIP-N-DALE, wear

Karl comment, no Chippendale attire

Whitey – I always go with Michelin
